Neither clinical signs and symptoms, nor a negative CSF cell count or chemistry CSF cell count and chemistry are helpful in excluding the diagnosis of listeriosis However, *L monocytogenes* is easily cultured from clinical specimens obtained from sterile sites (CSF, abscess fluid, blood)
